### Reinstatement Planning Worksheet

Be prepared for Reinstatement by completing the next steps in the eligibility process.  
Find out what classes may be repeated and research where to take them.

1. Review the CSUEB transcript with a Readmission
2. Identify and list courses in which a grade of C-, D+, D, F, WU, or IC were earned
3. Determine where each course may be repeated: Open University @ CSUEB, community college, or another college/university
  - a. List specific community college or college/university if applicable
  - b. Find an equivalent course(s) that may be repeated outside of CSUEB by using the Transfer Equivalency System ([TES](#))
