After you have accepted an offer of admission to a CSU campus, you must submit a petition to the Chabot Admissions Office requesting CSU GE certification. If CSU GE isn't completed prior to transfer, partial certification of CSU GE is also available. CSU certification is automatic for students who apply for, and earn, AA-T or AS-T degrees.
