

Policy Statement

IMMUNIZATION AND VACCINES

Student clinicians in the department are mandated to complete the immunization/vaccines indicated in this policy. These requirements follow CSU Policy as well as the guidelines for health care personnel set by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as it pertains to immunizations, immune status and TB screening.

Prior to enrolling in any clinical practicum courses, students must provide the following criteria:

1. Proof of negative tuberculin (PPD) test (within the past 3 months)
2. Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap) within the past 5 years.
3. Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) vaccine.

Additionally, it is recommended that students consider getting the Hepatitis B, Meningococcal B and flu vaccinations. If you have a medical reason for not getting a required immunization,
